On November 13, 2006 my son, Army Sgt. Joshua Cope, was critically injured in Iraq when his humvee was hit by an improvised explosive device. He lost both of his legs below the knees and sustained injuries to both hands. Seeing the pain and anguish of my son and so many of our wounded military soldiers, I have decided to provide retreats free of charge for combat wounded soldiers and their families and families of the fallen soldiers from the Iraq and Afghanistan war. I solicit local condos, resorts, motels, restaurants and businesses to donate their services free of charge for these retreats. Those that can't donate their services, I pay for those services provided to the soldiers with monies donated to the organization from the public. I schedule retreats twice a year held in Panama City Beach, Fl. Each retreat last for 3-4 days. I am in charge of all the planned events. These retreats provide 1) a means where wounded soldiers can communicate with other soldiers who have experienced similar circumstances 2) relief from stress and anxiety of their daily lives for a short period of relaxation 3) support for each other during difficult times in their personal lives. My vision is for this organization to be a role model to the nation to encourage other communities across the nation to organize and provide similar retreats in their own cities. I have attached three responses from soldiers who recently attended one of these retreats.
